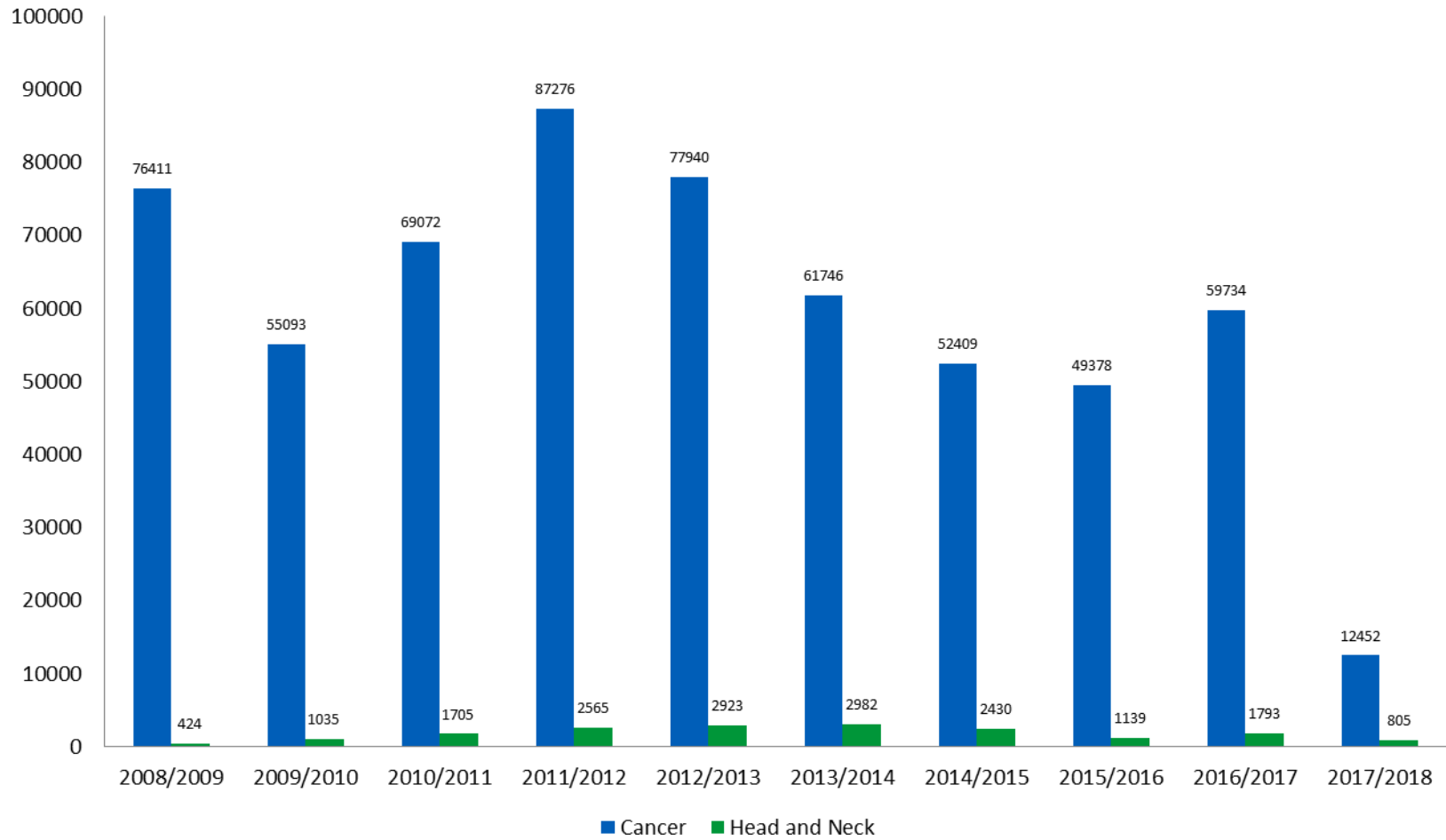
Cancer – National Sub-Specialty 2017-18 Recruitment Ranking (Adjusted by Population)



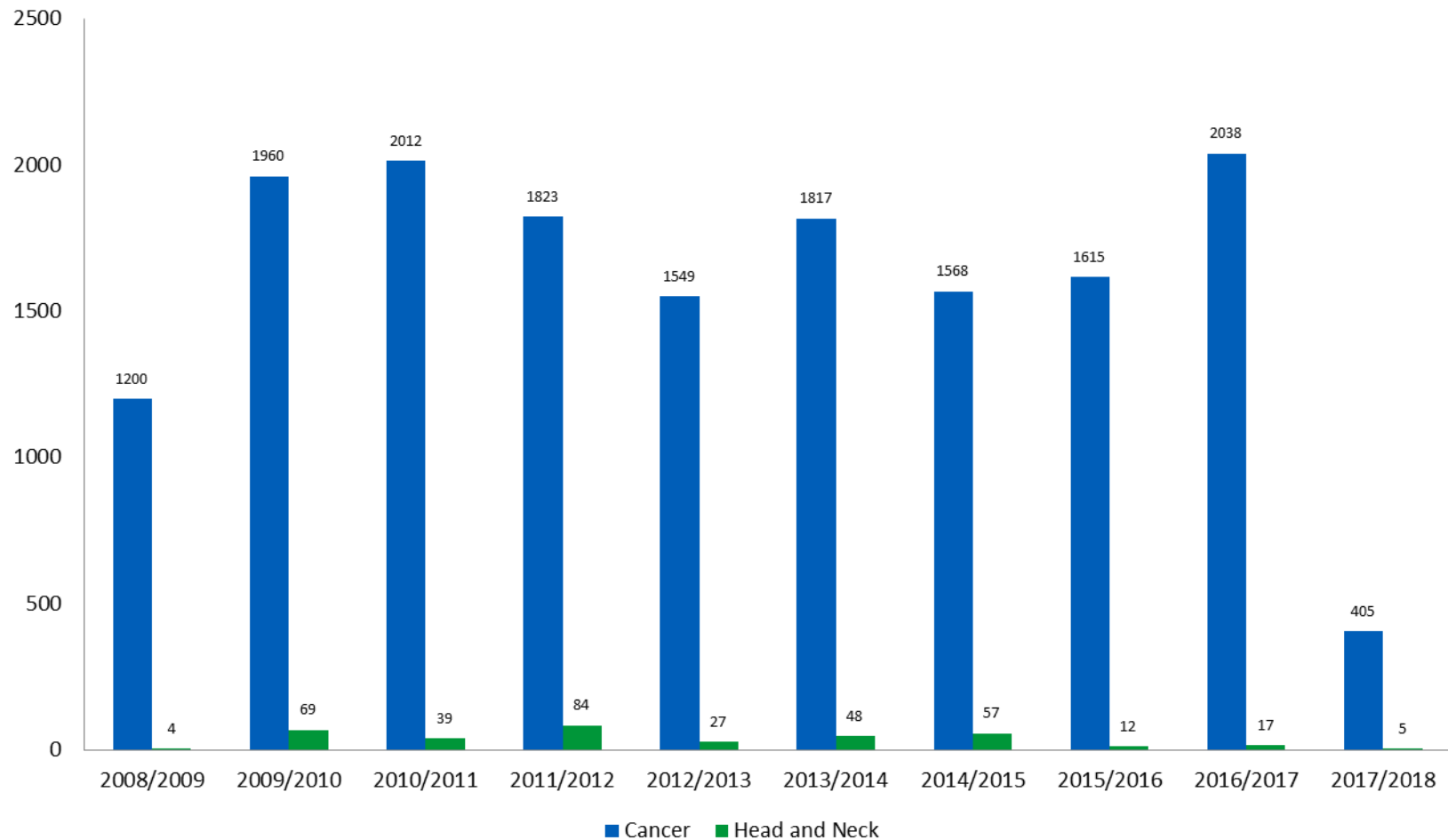

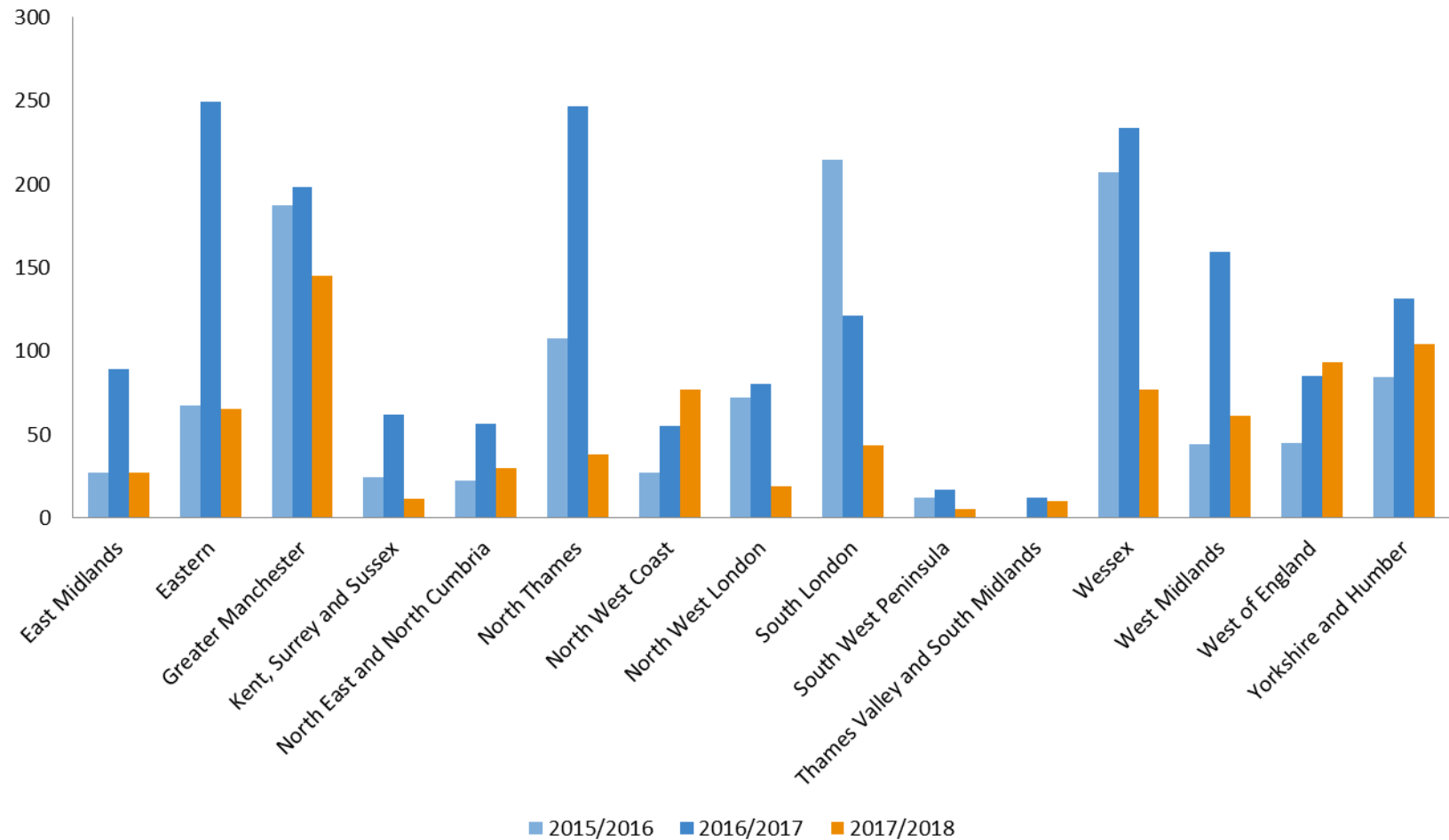
