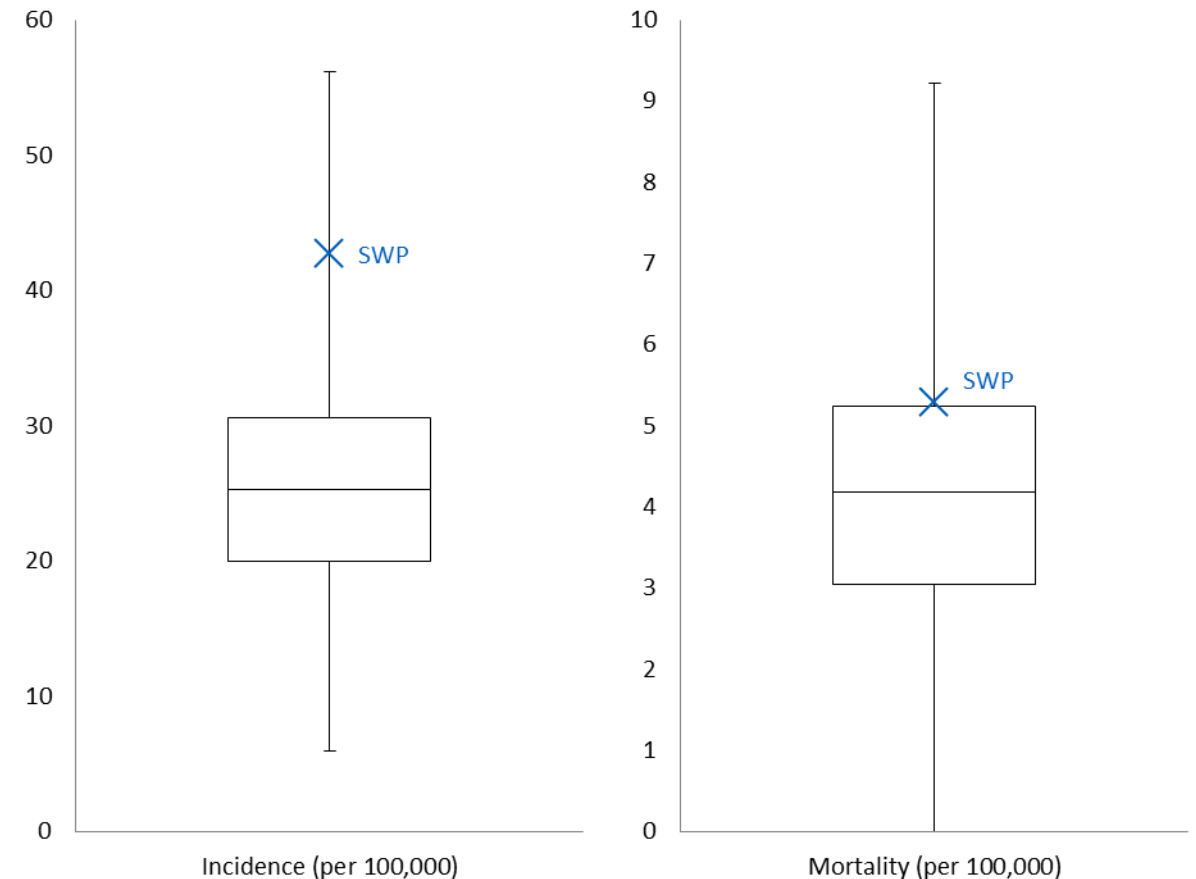
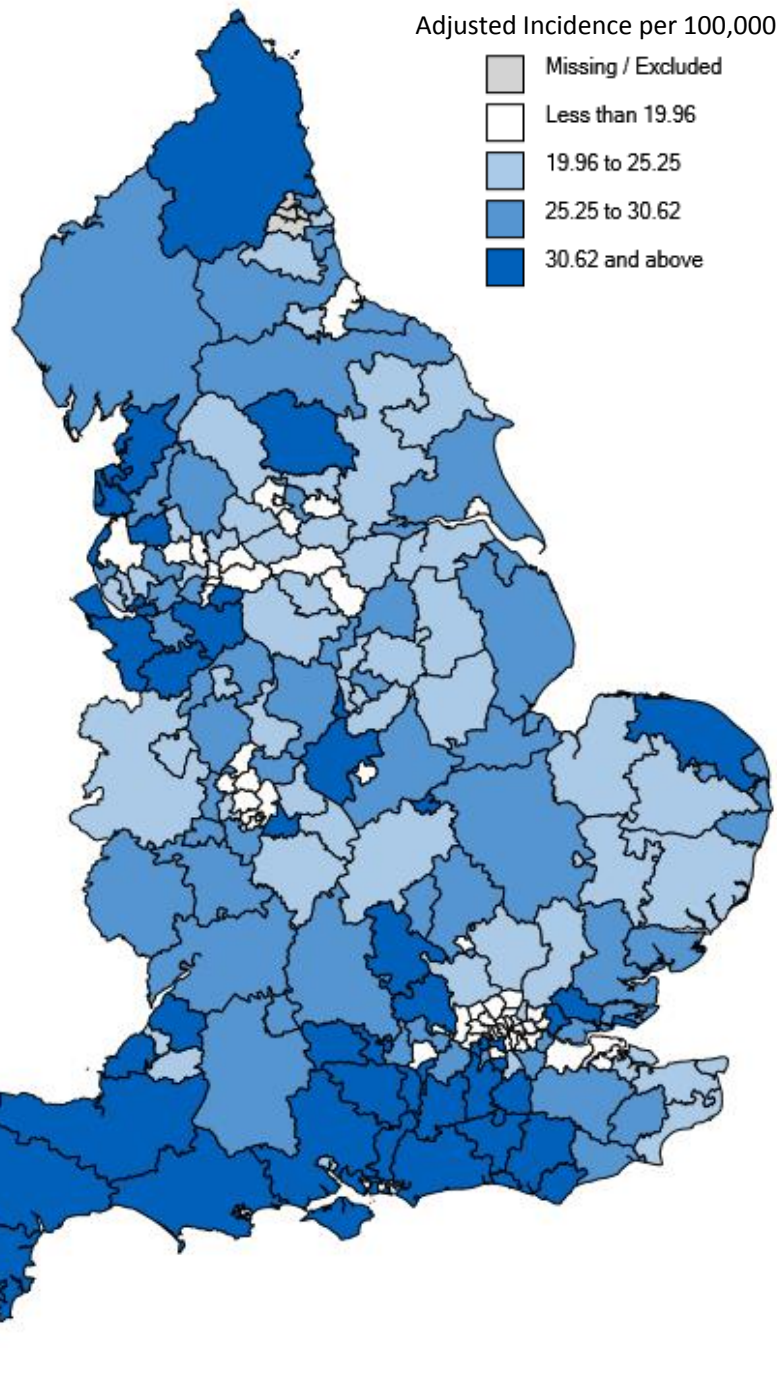


Malignant Melanoma Incidence and Mortality in 2014

In 2014 all four Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) in the South West Peninsula region were in the **top quartile** for malignant melanoma incidence – signified by dark blue on the map



A total of **977** people were diagnosed with malignant melanoma in the South West Peninsula region in 2014, an average age standardised rate of **43** per 100,000 population. Locally NHS South Devon and Torbay CCG had the highest incidence rate at **56** per 100,000 and NHS Somerset CCG had the lowest at **34** per 100,000

Mortality rates for CCGs in the south west peninsula were more spread than incidence rates, with an average mortality rate of **5** deaths per 100,000 population.
